They were treated to viewing a piece of the bar that was recued after the fire that destroyed the Rustic building in 1980. Also on display were pictures of the Rustic, musical items from the era, clothing of the time period and items from the



band, The Wylds. Memories shared that evening of the dance hall covered the spectrum of going there to the dances on Saturday nights, or staying outside and not going in; meeting their partner there or witnessing people becoming engaged there.

The museum continues their **Third Thursday Free Nights** on May 20 with a look at a STEM project. STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math and with this project the museum invites all ages to construct a model kit of an Inclined Plane. An inclined plan or ramp is used numerous places throughout the museum, especially in the farming exhibit. An incline plane is one of the six classical simple machines defined by Renaissance scientists. The inclined planes enabled workers to transfer their load from one level to another more easily. The museum will be open from 5:30-8:00 p.m. this night.
